INDIANS REGISTERED IN LUXEMBOURG

Evolution since 2013:

From 2018 to 2019: a 24.5% increase From 2013 to 2019: a 197.7% increase

The Indian citizens represent the 5th biggest diaspora outside the EU living and working in Luxembourg and 14th among the foreign citizens living in the Grand Duchy, compared to 27th in 2015.





BILATERAL FINANCIAL AND ECONOMIC RELATIONS

- ✗ 70% of the services exchanged on a bilateral level are financial services.
- Participation at the "Raisina Dialogue" in January 2020 of the CEO of the <u>Lux. Stock Exchange</u> (LuxSE) and the Founder of the <u>Green Exchange</u> (LGX), the first worldwide created in 2016.
- ✗ LuxSE was the second Stock Exchange to list Masala Bonds in 2008.
- Indian Global Depositary Receipts (GDRs) listing started back in June 1992. For Indian issuers, as of January 2020, LuxSE has listed 48 GDRs.
- Che India GDR Index was set up in January 2009.
- Among the Indian IT companies represented in Luxembourg, are Tata Consultancy Services, Wipro, Tech Mahindra, Infosys, Syncordis, Quantum Business Advisory and Damco Solutions.
- More than 25 Luxembourgish companies are operational in India, including ArcelorMittal, Paul Wurth, SES, Ceratizit, Rotarex, IEE, Amer-Sil Ketex, Tractel Secalt active for more than 2 decades, many of which are actively contributing to "Make in India".

BUSINESS, EDUCATION, CULTURE

- Partnerships between the University of Luxembourg and the Indian Institutes of Technology in Madras, Bombay and Kanpur and the National Law School of Bangalore. The University of Luxembourg counts a few hundred Indian students, which are mainly PHD students. <u>Scholarships</u> are available to Indian nationals.
- The Indian Business Club Luxembourg (IBCL) was founded in 2009.
- The Indian Association Luxembourg (IAL) was founded in 1991 and plays an educational role sharing India's cultural history.
